- Mercy Rule:** AA Pioneer High School will adhere to the principles of good sportsmanship. The MHSAA rule of "running clock" will apply at all levels of interscholastic sport.
- Over Time:** Will be applied by MHSAA rules
- Pep Bands:** A pep band is allowed. Those with instruments will be allowed in the game. There must be a school director.
- Pass List:** AA Pioneer allows the following people in free as long as they are on the pass list: scouts, press, husbands and wives, principals, athletic directors, pep bands, athletic trainers, managers, cheerleaders, and police. Please FAX (734) 994-2172 or send us a list of those attending two days before the game.
- Ticket Prices:** All tickets are \$5. Please tell your fans we do not allow people out of the stadium once they have paid.
- Sportsmanship:** Please advise your spectators that sportsmanship is of the utmost importance. Unsportsmanlike behavior is cause for removal. Ask them to cheer for great plays no matter what color the jersey. No spectator is allowed on the field before, during or after the game. Students must wear shirts. Your cooperation is appreciated.
- Roster:** Please forward your roster ASAP. LEGHTON@aaps.k12.mi.us
- Concessions:** Food will be available that evening. Typical fare includes pizza, hotdogs, pop, water, candy, and popcorn.
- Restrooms:** There are four port-a-johns on the visitor's side of the stadium. Those who wish a traditional bathroom, these are located on the home team side behind the stands.
- Directions:** Coming from the North:  
Take US 23 South to M14 West. Exit the downtown Main Street exit. Stay on Main Street for about 3 miles. Pioneer High School is on the corner of Stadium and Main Street, on the southwest side of Main.
- Coming from the South:

Take US 23 North to I-94 West. Exit the Ann Arbor-Saline Exit. Turn right (north), about a mile. Pioneer High School is on the left across from the University of Michigan golf course. The school is located on the west side of Main.

Coming from the East:

Take I-94 west. Exit the Ann Arbor-Saline Exit. Turn right (north), about a mile. Pioneer High School is on the left across from the University of Michigan golf course. The school is located on the west side of Main.

Coming from the West:

Take I-94 East. Exit the Ann Arbor-Saline Exit. Turn left (north), about a mile. Pioneer High School is on the left across from the University of Michigan golf course. The school is located on the west side of Main.

**Entrances to the Grounds** Athletic venues are located on the southeast portion of the school grounds. There are two large parking lots where buses and cars can park. Handicapped parking is designated in each of the lots. If you need to be driven to a venue because of a handicap please call the school at least 48 hours in advance and there will be someone designated to assist you from the parking lot to the venue.
